St Patrick's—The Society of St. Vincent de Paul wishes to thank everyone who donated to our Christmas appeal. We distributed \$15,570 in Sobeys food vouchers. There were 132 Home visits made to a total of 195 adults and 68 children. Each child got a \$50 gift card to the Halifax Shopping Center. Our giving tree raised \$3,555 in support of our Christmas help program. Our Total help was \$19,170.




PARISH NEWS
